


DM-307 for Ableton

Installation Instructions


Thank you for purchasing *DM-307 for Ableton*. *DM-307 for Ableton* packs contain multi-sample Drum Racks, Loops (Full and Stems) and One Shots (samples used to create the Loops and Drum Racks) taken from the Multis and Groove presets in Heavyocity's Award-Winning *DM-307: Modern Groove Designer* virtual instrument.

Installation


- 1. Download and install the Continuata downloader tool from your download email.
- 2. Open Continuata and enter the serial included in your download email. Select a destination and initiate download.
- 3. Once downloaded, double-click the "*DM307 for Ableton XXXXX*.alp" pack. You must have Ableton installed prior to opening the pack.
- 4. Ableton will launch and you will be prompted to select a destination for the Pack. Pick a location and remember it. You will need to navigate there to load the content into your Ableton project. Click "Open" to install the Pack.



5. Next, click the "Add Folder" shortcut under the Ableton "Places" section in the Ableton Browser.



5. Navigate to the installed pack and add it to your "Places" for easy access.



Content

You will find 4 folders in each Pack:

- <u>Drum Racks</u> contains various Drum Racks, each with multi-sampled cells organized in standard MIDI format. There are two levels of macros per rack: 1. Hit/Sample - select and control each individual sample's parameters and 2. Master Macro - apply master effects to the rack as a whole
- 2. <u>Loops</u> Loops organized by artist and/or genre, both full and stems
- 3. <u>One Shots</u> Drum Rack samples organized by type for easy browsing and use in other samplers.
- 4. <u>Samples</u> sample pool used by Drum Racks. **NOTE: DO NOT EDIT or DELETE**
